

<p>Equipment provided:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ 1m (width) X 2m (height) Exhibition Panel for each person  <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Blu tack <p>** On-site printing is NOT provided</p>
<p>Preferred format:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ In English➤ The size of the poster must not exceed the 1m (width) X 2m (height) exhibition panel, A0 size (841mm x 1189mm) is preferred➤ Vertical orientated➤ The full title, list of author(s) and affiliation(s) at the top➤ 24 to 32 font size single spaced is recommended, 48 to 60 font size for headings➤ A balance of figures and texts➤ Use dark colors on white or pale backgrounds and light colors on dark backgrounds➤ Do not write or paint directly on the exhibition panel
